Perdeblokke Sauvignon Blanc



Vintage	2021
General	Perdeblokke' refers to the horses that tilled the soils of the steep vineyard located 200-220 metres above sea level on the slopes of the Constantiaberg, after which it was named. Since it was planted, the 'Perdeblokke' has yielded grapes of the highest quality giving us a distinctly unique Sauvignon Blanc, which prompted the decision to produce the first vintage of this 'single vineyard' wine in 2005. It is only made in years of exceptional quality.
Description	Bright and light with a straw-like appearance. Leading with subtle aromas of green fig, lime, blackcurrant and lavender, both the nose and palate are engaged with elegant full bodied flavours of aromatic citrus flavours. The palate is linear and crisp. A vibrant acidity enhances a long lingering mineral finish to the wine.
Grape variety	100% Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc
Wine record	The vineyard is harvested at 4o'clock in the morning in order to preserve the freshness of the grapes. It is divided into 2 sections; one East facing and the other South facing. Grapes from each block are fermented and vinified separately allowing each to express their unique style and true terroir. The wine underwent natural fermentation initially in tank, followed by oak. It was left on the lees for a period of 9 months before blending and bottling.
