<b>Vintage</b>	2015
<b>General</b>	Grapes are selected from a single block, one of the oldest located on the lower slopes of Klein Constantia. Harvested early in the season in numerous batches to ensure complexity in freshness, fruit and intensity.
<b>Description</b>	Bright and pale gold in appearance. An intense nose with vibrant flavours of stone fruit and citrus blossom, with a hint of brioche and lime zest. The upfront palate boasts precise bubbles, a concentrated mousse and lively fresh citrus flavours concluding with a crisp flinty finish.
<b>Grape variety</b>	100% Chardonnay
<b>Wine record</b>	The grapes were whole-bunch pressed using only the free-run juice and fermented, before being aged in stainless steel tank for 7 months. Following blending, bottling and secondary fermentation, the wine was aged for a further 33 months before disgorging.

<b>Maturation</b>	Made to enjoy on release but it will however reward maturation for a further few years in bottle.
