KC Sauvignon Blanc

General	Grapes were sourced from excellent quality vineyards in the Cape Town area. Sauvignon blanc grapes best express their varietal flavours when grown in cool sites, therefore we aim to source from vineyards either close to the sea, or at a high altitude.
Description	Light and bright in colour. The nose is fresh and inviting, displaying aromas of tropical fruit and flint. These distinct aromas support a medium bodied palate and balanced acidity. The wine concludes with a full and lingering finish.
Grape variety	Sauvignon Blanc
Wine record	Grapes were chilled overnight before careful processing in the cellar. Fermentations lasted up to 4 weeks, where after the wines remained on gross lees for 2 months before blending.
