General	Grapes were sourced from top quality vineyards in Elgin, Walker Bay, Somerset West and Constantia. Given the warm, dry conditions leading up the harvest, the fruit quality was of the highest standard, and the resultant wine flavourful and full-bodied.
Description	Fresh green appearance. Melon, green fig and kiwi fruit aromas abound. The complex palate is rich and juicy with a fresh, flinty finish.
Grape variety	100% Sauvignon Blanc
Wine record	Purchased grapes were chilled overnight before careful processing in the cellar. Fermentations lasted up to 4 weeks, whereafter the wines remained on gross lees for 3 months before blending.
