Perdeblokke Sauvignon Blanc

General	The name Perdeblokke, refers to the horses that tilled the soils of the steep slopes that lie 200-220 metres above sea level on the slopes of the Constantiaberg mountain. Since it was planted, the Perdeblokke has yielded top quality and a distinctly unique Sauvignon Blanc, which prompted the decision to produce this special label wine in 2005. It is only made in years of exceptional quality.
Description	Leading with subtle aromas of blackcurrant and gooseberries, both the nose and palate are immediately engaged and enticed by complex layers of rich floral, citrus and berry flavours. The vibrant acidity adds poise and enhances the length and mineral finish of this wine. An exceptional expression of Klein Constantia terroir.
Grape variety	100% Sauvignon Blanc
Wine record	In order to make the best single vineyard wine, we divided the actual block into 4 portions. To increase the complexity and enhance characters present at different ripening stages, each portion was harvested at the perfect time. These sections were carefully basket pressed, settled and then partially fermented in Stainless steel tank before being racked to neutral 500L oak barrels for the final portion of fermentation. The wine was aged on the gross lees for a further 9 months before blending and bottling. In order to make the finest blend, we selected only the best 3 barrels to reflect the Perdeblokke vineyard.
