Perdeblokke Sauvignon Blanc

General	Perdeblokke' refers to the horses that tilled the soils of the steep vineyard located 200-220 metres above sea level on the slopes of the Constantiaberg, after which it was named. Since it was planted, the 'Perdeblokke' has yielded grapes of the highest quality giving us a distinctly unique Sauvignon Blanc, which prompted the decision to produce the first vintage of this 'single vineyard' wine in 2005. It is only made in years of exceptional quality.
Description	Straw-like in appearance with a light green hue. An intense nose bursting with aromas of blackcurrant, fig and flint. The palate is rich and fullbodied, yet precise and serious. A zesty mouthfeel with a crisp minerality that truly expresses the complex and energetic "Perdeblokke" terroir. The palate is complimented by a fine acidity, the wine concludes with a long saline finish.
Grape variety	100% Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc
Wine record	The vineyard is harvested at 4 o'clock in the morning in order to preserve the freshness of the grapes. It is divided into 2 sections; one East facing and the other South facing. Grapes from each block are fermented and vinified separately allowing each to express their unique style and true terroir. The wine underwent natural fermentation initially in tank, followed by oak. It was left on the lees for a period of 9 months before blending and bottling.
